Our goal is to create a ceremony that matches that gravitas of an in-person event and makes full use of the advantages only possible online. At the same time, we are mindful of privacy. In this section, we will explain the ceremony format followed by some questions about how you would like to participate.

The ceremony will make use of both a Zoom web conference and a YouTube live stream. The Zoom conference will become our event stage, from which we'll play music, display slides, and address the audience. The YouTube live stream will then deliver this ceremony to guests. **Graduates are invited to join the Zoom conference while we ask that guests tune into the YouTube stream.** Any images, voice, or video in the Zoom event will be included in the YouTube stream.

Just as an in-person event would be limited to ISS grads and their invited guests, we will provide a link to the YouTube live stream for you to send to your guests. **There will be an archived recording of the event available for the duration of the retention period (to be determined by the UW Record Management Office).** Both the stream and recording will remain unlisted on YouTube so they will not appear in search results.

Our hope is that this solution not only provides an easy way for your loved ones to attend but also offers an unlimited number of seats so you may invite everyone on your list to celebrate this big day with you!
